## Peterborough City Centre is Changing...



In the next few years work will start on a series of exciting projects in Peterborough, including the North Westgate shopping development; a revitalized city centre including improvements to Cathedral Square and public spaces; the zero-carbon residential development at South Bank; and new homes at Fengate.

Meanwhile, Peterborough is undergoing another period of major growth with at least 25,000 new homes and 20,000

new jobs planned over the period 2001 up to 2021.

The studies will look at existing projects and other opportunities across the city centre and bring them together as a single, joined up plan to guide development and improvements to streets and spaces over the next 10-15 years.

Peterborough City Council and Opportunity Peterborough have commissioned two studies to help bring forward regeneration of the city centre.

### Peterborough City Centre Area Action Plan

#### What is the City Centre Area Action Plan?

The Area Action Plan (AAP) is a document that will help decide what should go where and how in the centre of Peterborough. Consultant's EDAW have been commissioned to work on the plan.

#### What does it cover?

The AAP will investigate development opportunities throughout the city centre as shown on the map.

### Peterborough City Centre Public Realm Strategy

#### What is the Public Realm Strategy?

The public realm strategy will look at what needs to be done to improve the quality of the key streets and spaces in the city centre. This work will be undertaken by consultants LDA Design.

#### What does it cover?

The Public Realm Strategy will cover the entire city centre and will include designs for Bridge Street, Long Causeway, Cathedral Square, Cowgate and Westgate.
